

Specialization Path 01 – 2D Film Production (12 Weeks)

Objective

Equip learners with advanced artistic, storytelling, and production skills required to conceptualize, design, animate, and deliver a professional-quality 2D animated film.

Week 01 – Advanced Concept Art & Visual Development

Topics Covered:

- Visual storytelling through concept art
- Shape language and visual psychology
- Style exploration (realistic, stylized, hybrid)
- Mood boards and color scripting
- Character and world ideation

Learning Outcome:

- Develop compelling visual concepts aligned with narrative tone
- Create cohesive style frames and mood boards for film projects
- Translate abstract ideas into production-ready visual directions

Week 02 – Character Design for Animation
